APPLICATION FOR CANDIDATES SEEKING TO TEMPORARILY FILL THE VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF COUNCILMEMBER FROM WARD 7 IN THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY

PART I. INTRODUCTION.

Councilman John Pettis, Jr. resigned his Ward 7 office effective May 31, 2018, creating a vacancy in the office. Pursuant to Oklahoma City Charter Article II, § 4, the Council of The City of Oklahoma City is required to appoint a qualified person to temporarily fill the vacancy. The appointee will serve only until a replacement Councilmember can be elected by the constituents of Ward 7 to serve the unexpired balance of the term of office of Councilman John Pettis, Jr. This application form is being provided to prospective qualified applicants who desire to be appointed by Council to temporarily serve in the office of Councilmember from Ward 7.

Prospective applicants are hereby notified that a special primary election will be held on August 28, 2018, and if needed, a special general election will be held on November 6, 2018, so that Ward 7 voters may elect the replacement Councilmember. At the time the elected replacement Councilmember is sworn in, the temporary appointee's service as Ward 7 Councilmember will end.

To assist Council in finding a qualified person to appoint to such vacant office, Council requests that this application form be fully completed by the prospective applicant and submitted to the City Clerk of Oklahoma City no sooner than Wednesday, May 23, 2018, and no later than Tuesday, May 29, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. Applications not submitted within this time period will not be considered by Council.

Applications not fully and accurately completed as requested below will not be considered by Council.

The final decision of Council concerning the appointment of a qualified person to temporarily fill the vacancy in the office of Councilmember of Ward 7 will be final and binding on all applicants for such appointment.

A. Legal Qualifications for Oklahoma City Councilmember:

The legal qualifications for holding the office of Councilmember from Ward 7 may be found in both the relevant provisions of the Oklahoma City Charter, as amended (hereinafter cited as "City Charter", followed by the appropriate section number), and in the relevant provisions of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes (hereinafter cited as "11 O.S.", followed by the appropriate section number), which title governs municipalities in Oklahoma. The qualifications for the office of Ward 7 Councilmember are:

- 1. City Charter, Article II, § 6, provides that to be eligible for office of Councilmember one must be a citizen of the United States and of the State of Oklahoma, at least twenty-one (21) years of age, a qualified voter in The City of Oklahoma City, a resident of the ward for which representation is sought for at least 6 months, and must have been for three (3) years immediately preceding his/her election a resident of The City of Oklahoma City or an area which has been annexed to and has become a part of the City.
- 2. City Charter, Article X, § 1, provides that candidates for the office of Councilmember must be residents of the ward; therefore, candidates for the office of Ward 7 Councilmember must be residents of Ward 7. Note, however, that City Charter, Article II, § 6, requires at least 6 months of residency in the ward for which representation is sought.
- 3. Title 11 O.S. § 8-101 provides that a municipal elected official must be a registered voter of the municipality in which he or she holds office, and if from a ward, an actual resident of his/her ward.
- 4. Title 11 O.S. § 16-110 provides that a candidate for a nonpartisan municipal elected office must be a registered voter at an address within the municipality, "or of the ward where the office is from a ward," for at least six (6) months prior to filing his/her declaration of candidacy for such office. (*Ref.* also 11 O.S. § 16-102(A)(last sentence).)
