
SUBJECT: FEBRUARY 2019 SALES AND USE TAX COLLECTIONS


The majority of the February remittance includes actual collections for the second half of December and estimated collections for the first half of January. Combined sales and use taxes for the General Fund are \$11,129,467 or 5.5% above projections for the year. The quarter cent increase to the General Fund on January 1, 2018 began impacting collections in March 2018 and will continue to affect year-to-year comparisons through February 2019.

## **General Fund Sales Tax**




## **Sales Tax Comparison to Other Cities**


