ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY SALES TAX CODE, CHAPTER 52, ARTICLE II, OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, 2010, BY THE ADDITION THERETO OF A NEW SECTION 52-23.8 PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF AN EXCISE TAX OF ONE-EIGHTH (1/8th) OF ONE SPECIFYING THE FUNDING OF CENT: OKLAHOMA CITY PARKS AS THE LIMITED-PURPOSE FOR WHICH SUCH EXCISE TAX SHALL BE EXPENDED; ESTABLISHING AN OKLAHOMA CITY PARKS LIMITED-PURPOSE TAX FUND; PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF SUCH TAX FUND; PROVIDING THAT THE EXCISE TAX LEVIED BY SECTION 52-23.8 SHALL BE CUMULATIVE TO ALL OTHER EFFECTIVE EXCISE TAXES LEVIED BY THIS CHAPTER: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FOR CODIFICATION, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Section 52-23.8 of Article II, Sales Tax Code, of Chapter 52 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2010, is hereby adopted to read as follows:

Chapter 52. TAXATION

ARTICLE II. SALES TAX CODE

- § 52-23.8. Excise tax of one-eighth (1/8th) of one cent levied upon gross proceeds or gross receipts; specifying the funding of Oklahoma City Parks as the limited-purpose for which the tax shall be expended; establishing an Oklahoma City Parks Limited-Purpose Tax Fund; providing for the administration of such tax fund; and providing for cumulative effect of such tax.
- (a) An excise tax in the amount of one-eighth (1/8) of one cent is hereby levied upon the gross proceeds or gross receipts derived from all sales taxable under the sales tax law of this State, including but not exclusive of the specific taxable sales and service transactions enumerated in Paragraphs (1) through (11), inclusive, of Section 52-20.
- (b) The additional excise tax levied pursuant to this Section 52-23.8 shall be expended only for the funding of Oklahoma City parks, including any or all the following:
 - (1) Funding for the replacement and addition of trees and plant materials but excluding funds for mowing grass in the parks;
 - (2) Funding necessary to initiate and carry out park programs including, but not limited to, athletic leagues, exercise classes, training and exercise areas for pets, and similar other outdoor activities;
 - (3) Capital improvements, but only for the following types of improvements: (a) new restroom facilities; (b) things necessary to conduct athletic activities such as soccer goals and baseball backstops; and (c) bleachers for public seating; and
 - (4) Funding of other operational expenses for Oklahoma City parks, including expenses normally associated with a major metropolitan park system.

- (5) Provided, the additional excise tax levied hereby shall not be expended to operate, maintain, improve, or otherwise benefit directly or indirectly any Oklahoma City park operated in whole or in part by any private, non-governmental foundation or other similar private entity.
- (c) There is hereby established a limited purpose tax fund to be known as the "Oklahoma City Parks Tax Fund" into which all revenues collected pursuant to this Section 52-23.8 shall be deposited. Money in the Fund shall be accumulated from year-to-year. The Fund shall be placed in an insured interest-bearing account and the interest which accrues to the Fund shall remain in the Fund. The Fund shall be non-fiscal and shall not be considered in computing any levy when the City makes its estimate to the excise board for needed appropriations. Money in the Fund shall be expended only as accumulated and only for the limited-purpose and related expenditures as specified in Subsection 52-23.8(b) above.
- (d) The excise tax levied pursuant to this section shall be cumulative of all other effective excise taxes levied by this chapter, including without limitation the excises taxes levied by Sections 52-20, 52-21, 52-22, and 52-23.6 of this chapter.
- **SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional, such section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases or portion of this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 3. CODIFICATION.** The provisions of Section 1 herein are to be codified as Section 52-23.8 of Article II, Sales Tax Code, of Chapter 52 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2010.
- **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** Upon approval by City voters at a general or special election called by the Oklahoma City
