


CURRENT PPA BOUNDARIES










SIDEWALK REQUESTS WITH PPA'S AND DOWNTOWN BOUNDARIES






SIDEWALK REQUESTS WITH PPA'S AND SCHOOLS










PLANNED BICYCLE NETWORK






Figure 2.7 Basic Lane Reduction


Figure 2.8 Lane Reduction Cross-Section






BICYCLE BRIDGE CONNECTIONS REQUESTS
