

Highway Commercial District
The C-HC District is intended to provide commercial facilities for the traveling public along freeways in those areas where surrounding urban development does not exist and normal urban services are not available. Commercial uses permitted are limited to those types which directly serve automobile and truck needs, and provide basic convenience goods for cross country travelers. Because these areas will be located in low density agricultural areas, their location should be limited to freeway or highway intersections. They should be relatively small in size, and care should be taken in the location and development of structures to minimize their impact on surrounding land uses.
