

Medical Marijuana

These use units are associated with various Medical Marijuana Industry operations. Said use unit associations, descriptions, and conditions may be subject to change as deemed necessary. All uses are subject to Oklahoma State regulation as enforced by the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.

The City of Oklahoma City may require Building, Electrical, Mechanical, and Plumbing Permit(s), or Licenses to establish, or operate, these uses before a Medical Marijuana Certificate of Compliance is issued as required to obtain Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) licensure.

8150.1 Agricultural Processing: General

Packing or processing of crops, and their byproducts, raised on or off the premises, including picking, cutting, sorting, and packaging, but not including canning, reduction, or other similar activities.

Typical MM Industry uses include indoor or outdoor cultivation and processing of product raised on or off site.

Special Permit in AA. Conditional Use in 0-1, 0-2, RC, NB, C-1, C-2, C-3, C-4, C-CBD, C-HC, TP, I-1, I-2, and I-3

8150.2 Agricultural Processing: Limited.

Packing or processing of crops grown on the premises or by the processor, including picking, cutting, sorting, and packaging, but not including canning, reduction, or other similar activities.

Typical MM Industry uses include indoor or outdoor cultivation and processing of product raised on site.

Permitted Use in AA. Conditional Use in, 0-1, 0-2, RC, NB, C-1, C-2, C-3, C-4, C-CBD, C-HC, TP, I-1, I-2, and I-3.

8350.3 <u>Custom Manufacturing.</u>

Establishments primarily engaged in the on-site production of goods by hand manufacturing, which involves only the use of hand tools or small mechanical equipment not exceeding two horsepower or a single kiln not exceeding eight kilowatts, and the incidental direct sale to consumers of only those goods produced on-site.

Typical MM Industry uses include manufacturers of edible marijuana products including non-hazardous chemical, or chemical free extraction. Growing is permitted as an accessory use with a condition that products grown may only be used as a process component of the on-site manufacture of edible marijuana products.

Permitted Use in NB, C-2, C-3, C-4, TP, I-1, I-2, I-3, C- CBD, DBD, DTD2, NC- 4 and 5G, and DTD-1 except specific areas as defined in Section 59-7200.3.B(1)(a) and (b) where the use is not permitted.

8350.8 Industrial, Light.

Establishment engaged in the indoor manufacturing, assembly, fabrication, packaging or other industrial processing of finished parts or products, primarily from previously prepared materials, or the indoor provision of industrial services, where there are few external effects on adjacent properties.

Typical MM Industry uses include manufacturers of extracts and tinctures (through the use of hazardous chemicals) and waste grinding operations where all processes are indoors. Growing is permitted as an accessory use with a condition that products grown may only be used for the on-site production of extracts and tinctures.

Permitted Use in TP, I-1, I-2, I-3, BC, DTD-2, and DTD-1 except specific areas as defined in Section 59-7200.3.B(1)(a) and (b) where the use is not permitted. Special Permit Use in DBD

8350.7 Industrial, Moderate.

Establishments engaged in the manufacturing, assembly, fabrication, packaging, or other industrial processing of products, primarily from extracted or raw materials.

Typical MM Industry uses include waste grinding with outdoor operations or with outdoor storage.

Permitted use in I-2, and I-3. Special Permit use in DTD-2.

8300.52 Medical Services: General.

Establishments primarily engaged in the provision of personal health services, including related retail sales activities.

Typical MM Industry uses include medical offices. <u>This use can only be used if a licensed Medical Doctor is on premise.</u>

Permitted Use in RC, NB, C-1, C-2, C-3, C-4, C-CBD, TP, I-1, I-2, BC, DBD, DTD-2, 4G and 5 of NC, SYD, and DTD-1 except specific areas as defined in Section 59-7200.3.B(1) (a) and (b) where the use is not permitted. Conditional Use in 0-2.

8300.63 Retail Sales and Services: General.

Establishments engaged in the sale or rental of goods and services, both retail and wholesale, of commonly used goods, merchandise, and services. Excluded are retail sales establishments that would be classified as Retail Sales and Services: Pawn Shops (59-8300.65).

MM use units, continued.

Typical MM Industry uses include medical marijuana dispensaries. Growing is permitted as an accessory use with a condition that products grown may only be sold, directly to the consumer, by the on-site dispensary. Additional district restrictions may apply

Permitted Use in NB, C-2, C-3, C-4, C-CBD, 1-1, 1-2, 1-3, BC, DBD, DTD-2, 4G and 5 of NC, SYD, and DTD-1 except for Cottage District & Area-2. Conditional Use in 0-2.

8300.62 Research Services: Restricted.

Administrative offices plus research facilities of a technical or scientific nature which are located within a completely enclosed building. There is no product manufacturing, display, or sales activity, and no outside storage

Typical MM Industry uses include medical research facilities, product testing laboratory or a pharmaceutical laboratory.

Permitted Use in 0-2, NB, C-3, C-4, C-CBD, TP, I-1, I-2, I-3, BC, DBD, DTD-2, 4G and 5 of NC, SYT, and DTD-1 except specific areas as defined in Section 59-7200.3.B(1)(a) and (b) where the use is not permitted.
