As a member of the Oklahoma City Employee Retirement System (OCERS), you are required to make contributions, which are automatically deducted from your earnings. Your contributions are tax-deferred and are not taxable until you terminate your employment and elect to receive the proceeds either as a monthly retirement benefit, if eligible, or a lump sum payment. In the event of your death while employed with the City of Oklahoma City, certain conditions may make all or a portion of your contributions payable in a lump sum. The contributions may be paid only to your designated beneficiary, or the executor and/or administrator of your estate. Under the provisions of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code it is mandatory that you designate a beneficiary of your retirement contributions. You may designate your estate as a beneficiary.

You may change or cancel your beneficiary and/or custodian designations at any time, provided it is in a form acceptable to OCERS, and submitted to OCERS prior to your death or incapacity.
