- Largest MTC site for full-time students


## **Primary Justification for Funding**

- Remodel practicality and aesthetics to old campus (upgrades to chillers, boilers, flooring, roofing, restrooms, etc.)
- Create Centers of Excellence for Career Training Programs (national model for industry involvement)
- Be a catalyst for community improvement, beautification, and socioeconomic progression.
- Cannot do this project without alternative sources of funding (recent funding cuts)?
   \$739K and counting for FY16)


