Building projects in the City's design review districts require a Certificate of Approval prior to obtaining a building permit. Work on approved projects may not commence until after the mandatory 10-business day appeal period starting from the date of approval. **BCA-23-00008 (R3) at 2 NE 2nd Street** (Bricktown). Application by Tim Zajac, ADG/Blatt, for Don Karchmer, ParkFirst@Bricktown, LLC, to: 1) Revise the building footprint and floor plans at each level at the southwest corner of the building to avoid the underground sanitary sewer line and the associated easement; 2) Install light fixtures (both freestanding poles and wall attached fixtures) at the top deck of the parking structure; 3a) Relocate the approved signage at the revised southwest corner of the building to reflect the altered building facades; 3b) Construct new freestanding sign to the west of the project entry driveway at NE 2nd St; 4) Revise the project landscape plan to reduce the amount of landscape points but still satisfy the minimum landscape point requirements; and 5) Remove existing set of security gates at the NE 2nd St entry drive.
