- Have you ever found your child playing with matches or lighters?
- Does your child have an unusual fascination with fire?
- Has your child ever been involved in intentionally or unintentionally starting a fire?
- Does your child ask questions about fire that you find difficult to answer?

WHY YOUTH SET FIRES

There are many motives and factors influencing youth firesetting. Some children set fires out of curiosity, thrill-seeking, as a cry for help, with willful intent to cause destruction, or due to mental or emotional disorders. Children do not often fully realize the destructive power of fire. Although curiosity with fire is normal, setting fires should not be considered "normal" behavior.

Youth may have easy access to lighters or matches, lack supervision, or lack fire safety training. Many youth have easy access to examples of unhealthy fire behaviors on the internet. These are all issues that we can work with your family on.

EDUCATION IS THE ANSWER

We have Fire Officers on staff that are trained to help. These Fire Officers are trained according to National Fire Protection Association 1035 – Youth Firesetter Intervention Specialist I and II. We will speak with you and your child in a confidential environment. Intervention and education are free, nonpunitive, comprehensive, and effective.
